



# CW3 Juniors U10 & Rec Travel | Fall 2018

## Game Card Procedures

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### Game Cards:

1. Game cards should be printed a day in advance by a Team Official for the home team.
2. The Home Team is responsible for printing 3 copies of the game card. The game card will show both home and away team rosters.
  - **To print Game Cards within Got Soccer:**
    - Go to [www.gotsoccer.com](http://www.gotsoccer.com), Login, Team and Team Officials.
    - Login under the TEAM user name and password that is listed inside your coach's folder. *DO NOT USE YOUR COACHES ACCT.*
    - Within the box labeled "Event Registration History" click on view under "Schedule" in the WSSL – Fall 2018 – Recreational Event.
    - Your schedule will come up, please click on the PDF button on the left to view/print your game report.
    - Print 3 copies and bring with you to the game. One copy for the opposing team, one for the referee and one for your records.

### Game Day Procedures for Game Cards:

1. Prior to the start of the game, Team Officials for both the home and away teams should make sure the following is completed on each Game Card:
  - a. All player numbers are listed, these can be handwritten. You may also add these into your Team Got Soccer Account. (See instructions below titled: *Enter/Change Jersey #'s on Game Cards*)
  - b. For any teams using Club Guest players, the Club Guest Player MUST be listed. These can also be handwritten.
  - c. Any player or team official sitting out for Red/Yellow cards, team discipline or injury should be noted.
2. After complete Step 1, give copies of the game card to the Referee(s). Prior to the start of the game, the referee should complete the following:
  - a. Print their own names, where indicated, on the game card.
  - b. Using the game card, check in the players of both teams and Note their presence with a mark next to their name.
3. Following the finish of the game, Referee(s) should make sure the following is completed:
  - a. Final score for each team is recorded.
  - b. Any Yellow or Red cards received are recorded. There should be a mark next to the offending players name and for Red Cards received, an explanation given on the back of each copy of the game card.
  - c. A Team Official from BOTH teams should sign, where indicated, at the bottom of each game card.
  - d. An Official from the winning team (or home team in case of a tie) receives a copy of the game card and an official from the other team receives another copy.

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4. The WINNING TEAM or Home Team in the case of a tie is responsible for completing the following **within 48 HOURS OF THE FINISH OF THE GAME.**
  - a. Reporting the game score and any cards received into Got Soccer. Specific information is provided below regarding Red/Yellow Card offenses.
  - b. To Phone in scores and cards received: 1-904-758-0875
    - Update Game Record: Press 1
    - Event ID: 54149, followed by the #
    - Pin: 1234, followed by the #
    - Enter the game number, followed by the #
    - To enter scores: Press 1 and then follow the prompts
    - To enter yellow card: Press 2 and then follow the prompts
    - To enter red card: Press 3 and then follow the prompts

### Enter/Update Jersey #'s on Game Cards:

1. Login at [www.gotsoccer.com](http://www.gotsoccer.com) using your "Team" login and password.
2. You will see the **Home, Overview** screen for your team.
3. Locate the word **Roster** and click on it, this will pull up your roster.
4. Click on a player's last name and it will bring up the individual player information.
5. On this page, input the correct jersey # and scroll down to bottom to update player info.
6. Then, click on **Roster** again and the full roster will appear. The player's number will reflect the change you made.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** *Coaches can update jersey number(s) and the changes will be reflected on game cards up until the season begins. After the season begins, game cards are frozen by WSSL and can no longer be changed.*

### Red/Yellow Card Offenses:

#### Yellow Card Offenses:

1. Is guilty of unsporting behavior
2. Shows dissent by words or action
3. Persistently infringes the Laws of the Game
4. Delays the restart of play
5. Fails to respect the required distance when play is restarted with a corner or free kick
6. Enters or reenters the field of play without the referee's permission
7. Deliberately leaves the field of play without the referee's permission

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### **Red Card Offenses – Send Offs:**

The following offenses will result in a 1 game suspension for the player:

- Denies an opponent a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball
- Denies an opponent a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by committing an offense punishable by a free kick or a penalty kick

The following offense will result in a 2 game suspension for the player:

- Is guilty of serious foul play

The following offense will result in a game suspension for the player or a 2 game suspension for the coach if received by the coach or other team official:

- Receives a second caution (yellow card) in the same match

The following offenses will result in a 2 game suspension for the player or a 4 game suspension for the coach if received by the coach or other team official:

- Is guilty of violent conduct
- Spits at an opponent or any other person
- Uses offensive, insulting or abusive language
